Course Information & Teaching Methods;

This course will suit anyone with a broad knowledge of watercolour techniques who wants to expand their knowledge of this medium. Techniques will include different ways of using wet-in-wet washes, drawing with brushes and other implements and combining watercolour with other media. Each technique will be introduced through examples, demonstrations and warm up exercises. The techniques will then be applied to your own choice of subject or that provided by the tutor. Individual help will happily be given throughout the course.

Equipment;

Please do bring any watercolour materials which you already have, although some watercolour paints will be available to borrow.

Paper is available to purchase in the art room.

The tutor will provide brushes to borrow for the first session and advice will be given for purchasing your own. If you do this before the course, please make sure they are of a good quality.
